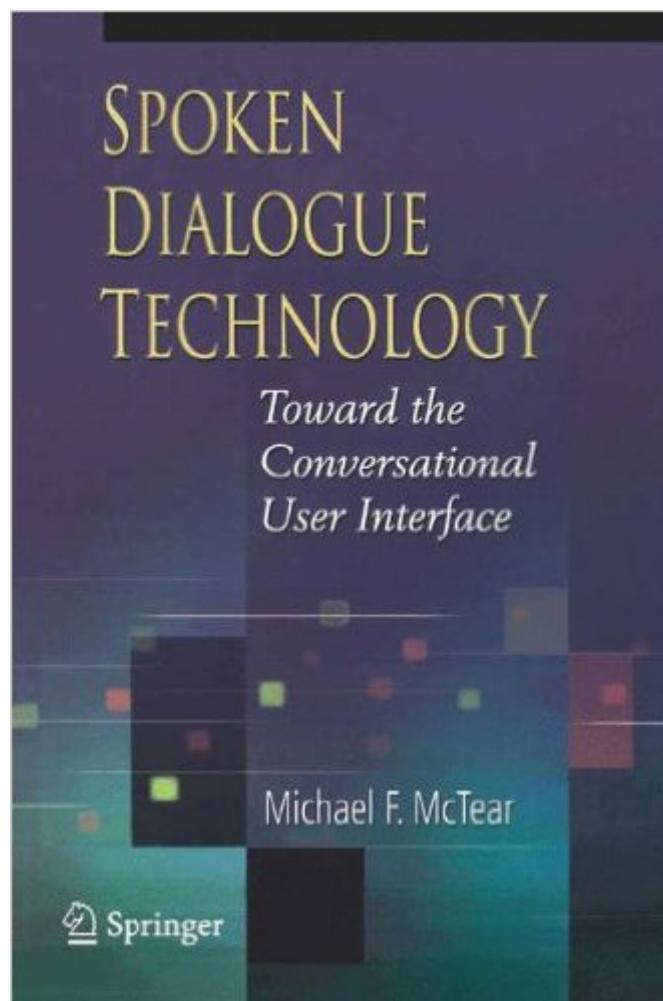

A dedicated web site containing supplementary materials, code, links to resources will enable readers to develop and test their own systems (.). Previously such materials have been difficult to track down, available only on a range of disparate web sites and this web site provides a unique and useful reference source which will prove invaluable.
